Dear Friends and Parishioners.

In response to the extraordinary circumstances related to the Coronavirus pandemic, St. Pius X Parish is immediately implementing the following - until further notice. These guidelines are in keeping with the most recent federal, state, and local health instruction mandates and the Diocese of Des Moines Guidelines issued by Bishop Joensen on March 17, 2020.

- 1. All public daily and weekend Masses are suspended until further notice. Priests will celebrate private Masses for the Mass intentions which have been offered. The bishop has dispensed everyone from the Sunday Mass obligation.
- 2. Individual Lenten Confessions will be offered in the church the following times (please respect distancing):

Tuesdays (9am-11am)Wednesdays (5pm-7pm)

• Fridays (9am-11am and 5pm-7pm)

Saturdays (3pm-5pm)

- 3. The upcoming liturgical events have been cancelled:
 - Stations of the Cross (Fridays of Lent)
 - Mass of the Anointing of the Sick (March 21st)
 - Parish Communal Reconciliation Service (March 26th)
- 4. All meetings or communal gatherings of parish committees and any other groups are cancelled.
- St. Pius X School classes and Parish Faith Formation programs have been cancelled until the week of April 14th, 2020. For more details, concerning St. Pius X School, go to the school website at (<u>www.stpiusxschool.org</u>).
- 6. Scheduled celebrations of First Communion and Confirmation are suspended. Alternative plans and dates for these celebrations are being developed with the assistance of the diocese.
- 7. The official March 29th launch of the Parish Capital Campaign, "Living Our Mission Building Our Future" has been temporarily suspended. More detailed information will be sent out later.
- 8. The main church will be open from 8:30am 4:00pm for private, individual prayer. The west church entrance will be open.
- 9. The Adoration Chapel will remain open with its normal hours.
- 10. The parish office will remain open during the hours of 8:30am 4:30pm (Mon.-Fri.). However, please call ahead to make an appointment, as we may have a reduced staff. The office number is (515) 276-2059.

Bishop Joensen has invited us to a special day of fasting, abstinence, and prayer on **Friday, March 27, 2020** for an end to the pandemic and the healing aid of those who are afflicted by it in any way. See the bishop's pastoral Message on the parish or diocesan website (**www.dmdiocese.org**)
