- III. **Acceptance of Agenda** Mr. Sauer made a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Hayes seconded, and the agenda was approved as distributed.
- IV. **Approval of Minutes** Mrs. Marshall made a motion to approve the minutes with a technical correction, Mrs. Blakeley seconded, and the minutes from the November meeting were unanimously approved.

#### VI. Reporting

A. **Teacher Representative:** Mrs. Stubblefield said that in Fourth Grade, they are finishing reports on the saints. In Math, they are learning long division and in Social Studies, they have been studying the northeast region of the United States.

In Seventh Grade Language Arts, Mrs. Pedersen said that the students are working on constructed responses. The students are prereading for *The Outsiders* as well. In Eighth Grade Language Arts students are working on a poetry unit and are also working on verb conjugation. Mrs. Pedersen talked about student interaction saying that the Seventh Graders meet with their First-Grade buddies once a month and the Eighth Graders meet with their Second-Grade buddies twice a month.

Mr. Tallman shared that there has been much preparation for the Advent Season. Prayer services have been planned and a Mission Project to benefit refugee families is also planned. The students and staff will meet in their Field Day teams to discuss the needs of their refugee families and make cards. Mission Awareness Dress Down funds will be used to purchase gifts for the families. The gifts will be wrapped then blessed on December 21<sup>st</sup> during a Prayer Service. Following that, the gifts will be delivered to Catholic Charities to distribute to the families. Mr. Tallman shared information regarding Middle School Religion classes saying that Sixth and Eighth Grade students will be learning about the saints, Seventh Grade students will learn about vocations. Eighth Grade classes are also studying relics and making relic cards.

B. Administrator's Report: A written report was submitted. Ms. Kever said the Pius Pals program has hired a new regularly scheduled part-time employee. Andrea Farrell joined the staff on November 28<sup>th</sup> and will work weekdays in the afternoon. Ms. Kever also discussed the AdvanceEd Systems Accreditation Process and shared that teachers recently reviewed the ELEOT tool to evaluate learning environments based on student engagement. This will serve as a useful tool in ongoing review and goal setting. Parents, students and staff were invited to participate in the Catholic School Program Effectiveness Survey as a part of evaluating learning environments. Eighty-three parents, 33 teachers and 125 students in grades 5-8 completed the survey.

Teachers will be reviewing the data at December faculty meetings and a summary report of the parent feedback will be available during Catholic Schools Week in late January.

C. **Pastor's Report:** Father Fleming shared that he has been enjoying visiting classrooms and that he also conducts tours of the church and discusses Adoration with the students. Father said that the Children's Choir for Christmas Eve Mass now numbers 38 and will be led by Mrs. Holly Russell and Mr. Ryan Battani. Father also shared that Advent Communal Penance service is scheduled for Thursday, December 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.
